ON TRIAL-ROMANS 3:9-20 HOME WORSHIP GUIDE Week of October 31-November 6

Spend a few minutes reading the Scripture and thinking through one or more sections, individually or with your family. Reflect on Sunday's message and how it applies to your life today.

GOD

We learned this week that we are all sinners. Talk about ways that we use our time to know who God is, what He has done for us, and what what can do for Him. Pick a spiritual discipline to focus on this week at home for yourself and/or with your children. Contact a staff member if you need some new ideas or some help with this!

CHURCH

Read verse 19. The whole world is subject to God's judgment. One of the goals of bigKIDS Ministry is for children to understand that the church is God's plan for the redemption of the world. Review the BVBC Mission Statement and talk about why living out the mission of the church is the most important thing we could ever do: *The mission of Blue Valley Baptist is to glorify God by helping people everywhere understand what it means to follow Jesus using the Five Habits of Jesus Follower* (surrender, sustain, sacrifice, shine, share).

IDENTITY

Spend time this week reading and thinking about this passage and the two sermon points: (1) We are all guilty, (2) We all stand condemned. Have you ever gotten in trouble for something? Apply that to your position as a sinner before a righteous God and Jesus rescuing you from eternal judgment. Thank Him for taking your guilt and condemnation. Live a life of thankfulness in response to the freedom Jesus purchased for you.

Read the passage. If you do not have a specific person that does not know Jesus that you are intentionally reaching out to and building a relationship with, ask God to show you who that person should be. Then be on the lookout for who God shows you and begin to build a relationship with that person.



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
