HOME WORSHIP GUIDE

Week of September 19-25

Spend a few minutes reading the Scripture and thinking through one or more sections, individually or with your family. Reflect on Sunday's message and how it applies to your life today.

Read verse 8. What is the very first action? (*I thank my God.*) Spend some time making a list or talking about all the things and people you are thankful for. Every time you drive by a church, thank God for that church and ask God to help the Jesus followers there tell others the good news of Jesus.

Read the passage and take note of verse 13. What does Paul call other Christians? (*Brothers and sisters.*) Your brothers and sisters are not just at BVBC, but anyone who is a Jesus Follower in any location. Think about what our pastors said on Sunday about how to be involved in the global church. What can you as an individual or a family do to help your global perspective, to be a mutual encouragement, or to participate in our shared mission?
